


CoveringsETC in Pittsburgh Green Dream Home

The 4800sf home, featuring **CoveringsETC** products throughout, was designed in collaboration between renowned architect firms of **Hugh Newell Jacobsen** and **Seigle, Solow, and Horne** with the goal of merging contemporary architecture with a green footprint. Lou and Amy own a green products rep firm and offer the **ECOverings** lines in the Western PA region. The design and construction of the residence was planned in accordance with United States Green Building Council (USGBC) standards with the goal of meeting Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) requirements. The house is applying for LEED Platinum certification.

Bio-Luminum tiles, manufactured from retired aircraft, cover the kitchen walls and add a contemporary spark to the updated country kitchen, from where Amy oversees her well-stocked vegetable and flower garden. "The **Bio-Luminum** tiles are green of course but their texture and patina looks as if they were hand crafted by an artist", observes Lou.

Other sustainable features of the home include cork and rubber flooring, rainwater harvesting, windmill power and energy efficient spray foam insulation.



Bio-Glass was used in the bathrooms as well as in their sun soaked dining room where Amy, a seasoned cook, hosts Shabbat dinners every Friday. Noguchi paper lanterns suspend 12 feet over the dining room table, spawning a romantic feel. Their use of the material in multiple areas is an example of how **Bio-Glass** proves to be a versatile surface.
