BIO-GLASS® LIGHTS UP MIA LOUNGE



MIA, a unique restaurant and lounging concept designed by Isaac Valdes, brings global cuisine, live performance lounging and a fresh nightlife atmosphere to Downtown Miami. Bio-Glass is featured prominently in this amazing space with 14,000sf of rich stylistic elements. MIA is Valdes' first commercial project outside of Europe. Having studied and lived in Italy many years where there is a conscious effort to conserve natural resources in everything they do, recycling and sustainability are inherent in all of Valdes' designs.

More than 2,000sf of Bio-Glass is utilized throughout the space as both flooring and countertops. Its translucence is maximized through both white and colored LED strip lights... a metamorphic effect is made courtesy of alternating synchronized light patterns. There is also a motion-sensing iWall and iBar (multi-media installation), as well as club elements such as laser lighting and a high-caliber sound system.

Valdes designed the resto-lounge with the 4 elements in mind: Bio-Glass represents the source of life, 'water" as the terrace bar is under lit with white lights, 'fire" is depicted through the red lights streaming through the countertops in the bathrooms, "earth" by the use of slate and limestone covered walls, and 'wind" through the effects of lights, lasers, and non-toxic smoke machines.








MODERNISTS LOVE MANHATTAN HOUSE AND ECO-TERR®
